



**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR WRITING THE EXAMINATION**

**(Please read these instructions carefully)**

1. Ensure that the question booklet is complete in all respects. In case you have received a defective booklet, please exchange it within 15 minutes of the start of the examination from your hall invigilator.
2. Do not write anything else on the Test Booklet.
3. Don't detach or remove any sheet from the Question Booklet.
4. Candidates should **write the Reg.No and Code No in the OMR sheet and Reg.No. in the question paper compulsorily without fail.**
5. The correct answer is to be marked by darkening the circle prominently on the OMR Answer sheet by **BLACK BALL POINT PEN ONLY.**
6. This test booklet contains questions of objective type of 200 marks and all questions carry equal marks. You need to select **ONLY ONE** response which you want to mark on the **OMR sheet**. If darkening two answers, over marking, use of marker, white fluid or any other device, the particular question/answer will not be evaluated. Darken the **CORRECT** answer ex. For question No. **64**, if answer is "**D**" darken, like this.
